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Extracurricular Options

Venture School offers a one day a week face-to-face extracurricular program. At the beginning of the school year, all participating families are given a survey to discuss the best location and topics. The extracurricular classes can include surfing, kapa making, hula, art, music, or physical education. Parents have the option to stay and volunteer at the Venture School or drop students off.

Project-based subscription boxes are an at-home alternative offered to students who choose not to attend Venture School. In addition, field trips and community service opportunities are offered throughout the year to all members of participating families.

Teacher Support

Dedicated teachers support families with everything from curriculum selection to answering everyday questions. Tutoring is even available if desired! If parents notice the need for further support in a subject, they may request additional support through a dedicated **Student Success Team (SST)** at any time. The SST program allows for research-based interventions to be implemented at the first signs of struggle or concern without any hoops to jump through. Teachers can also help coordinate additional support through the school district.

Venture Reward

Every student receives \$1,000 in Venture Reward funding per school year to purchase educational items that support current courses. Many families have enjoyed using the Venture Reward for printers, technology, books, educational games, additional curriculum, and so much more! Please note that Venture Reward funds cannot be used to purchase a religiously-based curriculum.
