Welcome

Venture Upward provides tuition-free, home-based education for K-12th grade students through public school partnerships. Our comprehensive program includes curriculum, funding to support educational equity, community activities, and teacher support. With customized education plans and ongoing guidance, students thrive academically and personally.

Program at a Glance

With enrollment Venture Upward students receive:

Core Courses: K-8 students use customized online curriculum options such as Teaching Textbooks, Study.com, Mathseeds, Imagine Learning, Edgenuity, Studies Weekly, IXL, Power Homeschool, CTC Math, and more. High school students work in Edgenuity, Power Homeschool or High School Suites with access to additional supplemental educational resources.

Electives: Weekly on-site Venture School community day, two monthly subscription boxes, or unlimited access to hundreds of online courses through eDynamics.

Synchronous Classes: Teachers offer live, synchronous classes several times per week as an option for some families. Additionally, students have the option to join a variety of live, hands-on virtual enrichment classes such as cooking and art to Shakespeare, poetry, astronomy, nature journaling, and beyond.

Community Events: State family field trip, local field day, community service opportunities, and more.

Portfolio Option: K-8 alternative that allows students to keep using their own curriculum and turn in their work to align with state standards.

Venture Reward: Educational funding to support equity in learning.

Teacher Support: Individualized support, attention, and guidance.

Teacher Support

Dedicated Idaho teachers support families by answering general questions, providing curriculum support, tutoring, and more. If parents observe a need for additional support in an area, they may request support through Venture's highly qualified Student Success Team (SST) at any time. The SST program follows the Multi-Tiered Systems of Support structure using research-based interventions to be implemented at the first sign of struggle or concern.

Venture Reward

Every student receives Venture Reward funding each school year to access educational items. Many families have benefited from using the Venture Reward for printers, internet access, technology, books, education games, additional curriculum, and so much more! Please note that the Venture Reward funds cannot be used to purchase religious-based curriculum. All items remain the property of Venture Upward and will be invoiced if a student withdraws before the end of the school year.
